Recommendation:

Board to provide direction to staff

Background:

At the last meeting, Board requested staff to bring back budget numbers from consultants regarding the following:

- Costs for developing PWRA brand, logo, etc.
- · Public outreach campaign
- Website

With budget estimates for these items, the Board may direct staff to seek proposals from qualified consultants for evaluation and possible contracting. Staff has contacted two companies, IES and MBI Media, and the City's IT Department and our findings are as follows:

1. Design of a LOGO:

- IES will provide this service with the contract for Website design. Staff has to provide the preference.
- There are sites that staff can design logos for \$11/logo.
- MBI will provide this service with its contract.
- RMG Communications, JPW Communications & CV Strategies, firms with water experience, also may be contacted for their services.

2. Establishing a Website:

- City IT Department will provide this service cost unknown.
- IES will provide this service for \$2,900 and \$79/month for three years. Total cost is approximately \$5,700.
- MBI will provide this with its contract.
- RMG Communications, JPW Communications & Tripepi Smith, firms with water experience, also may be contacted for their services.

- 3. Public Outreach:
 - MBI will provide this service with its contract.
 - RMG Communications, JPW Communications & CV Strategies, firms with water experience, also may be contacted for their services.

MBI Media will provide logo, branding and the website, and provide Public Outreach. They indicated the cost can range from \$20,000 to \$30,000, depending on our request of services.

Financial Impact:

No financial impact of this decision. Staff time of both PRWA member agencies will be utilized to secure and assess proposals.
