RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE PALMDALE RECYCLED WATER AUTHORITY ADOPTING THE CONFLICT OF INTEREST AND DISCLOSURE CODE FOR THE PALMDALE RECYCLED WATER AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, the Political Reform Act ("Act"), Government Code Section 81000, et seq., requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate conflict of interest codes; and

WHEREAS, under the Act, the Authority must periodically review its internal organization to determine: (i) whether any position that has been added to the Authority constitutes a designated position under the Authority's Conflict of Interest and Disclosure Code ("Code"); or (2) whether the duties of any existing position that is currently not a designated position have changed such that the position now constitutes a designated position under the Authority's Code; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's Code was last an indeed by the District on February 19, 2014 (Resolution No. 2014-001).

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE PALMDALE RECYCLED WATER AUTHORITY DOES HEREBY FIND, DETERMINE, RESOLVE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Authority hereby adopts as its Conflict of Interest Code the terms of 2 California Code of Regulations Section 18730, and any amendments to it hereafter duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission, in the form attached hereto as Appendix 1.

SECTION 2. Exhibit "A" to the Authority's Conflict of Interest code shall set forth the disclosure categories for the Authority.

SECTION 3. Exhibit "B" to the Authority's Conflict of Interest Code shall set forth the designated positions and applicable disclosure categories for each position of the Authority.

SECTION 4: The Executive Director is authorized to file the Biennial Review Certification Form with the Board of Supervisors indicating amendments to the Code are not necessary.

APPENDIX 1

Conflict of Interest Code of the

PALMDALE RECYCLED WATER AUTHORITY

Incorporation of FPPC Regulation 18730 (2 California Code of Regulations, Section 18730) by Reference

The Political Reform Act (Government Code Section 81000, et seq.) requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate conflict of interest codes. The Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation (2 Cal. Code of Regs. 18730), which contains the terms of a standard conflict of interest code. After public notice and hearing, it may be amended by the Fair Political Practices Commission to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act. Therefore, the terms of 2 California Code of Regulations Section 18730, and any amendments to it duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission, are hereby incorporated into the conflict of interest code of this agency by reference. This regulation and the attached Appendices (or Exhibits) designating officials and employees and establishing economic disclosure categories shall constitute the conflict of interest code of this agency.

Place of Filing of Statements of Economic Interests

All officials and employees required to submit a statement of economic interests shall file their statements with the agency head; or his or her designee. The agency shall make and retain a copy of all statements filed by its Board of Directors and the Executive Director, and forward the originals of such statements to the Executive Office of the Board of Supervisors of Los Angeles County.

The agency shall retain the originals of statements for all other Designated Positions named in the agency's conflict of interest code. All retained statements, original or copied, shall be available for public inspection and reproduction (Gov. Code Section 81008).

PALMDALE RECYCLED WATER AUTHORITY

EXHIBIT "A"

CATEGORY 1

Persons in this category shall disclose all interest in real property within the jurisdiction of the Palmdale Recycled Water Authority. Real Property shall be deemed to be within the jurisdiction if the property or any part of it is located within or not more than two miles outside the boundaries of the jurisdiction or within two miles of any land owned or used by the Palmdale Recycled Water Authority. Persons are not required to disclose property used primarily as their residence.

CATEGORY 2

Persons in this category shall disclose all investments, and all business positions.

CATEGORY 3

Persons in this category shall disclose all income, (including gifts, loans and travel payments).

CATEGORY 4

Persons in this category shall disclose all business positions, investments in, and income (including gifts, loans and travel payments) received from business entities that manufacture, provide or sell service and/or supplies of a type utilized by the agency and associated with the job assignment of designated positions assigned to this disclosure category.

CATEGORY 5

Individuals who perform under contract the duties of any designated position shall be required to file Statements of Economic Interests disclosing reportable interest in the categories assigned to that designated position.

In addition, individuals who, under contract, participate in decisions which affect financial interests by providing information, advice, recommendation or counsel to the agency which could affect financial interest shall be required to file Statements of Economic Interests, unless they fall within the Political Reform Act's exceptions to the definition of consultant. The level of disclosure shall be as determined by the executive officer (or head) of the agency. (See footnote in Exhibit "B" for clarification.)

^{*}Consultants/New Positions are included in the list of designated positions and shall disclose pursuant to the broadest disclosure category in the code, subject to the following limitations:

The Executive Director or his or her designee may determine in writing that a particular consultant or new position, although a "designated position," is hired to perform a range of duties that is limited in scope and thus is not required to fully comply with disclosure requirements in this section. Such written determination shall include a description of the consultant's or new position's duties and, based upon that description, a statement of the extent of disclosure requirements. The Executive Director or his or her designee's determination is a public record and shall be retained for public inspection in the same manner and location as this conflict-of-interest code. (Gov. Code Section 81008.)

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE PALMDALE RECYCLED WATER AUTHORITY ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT FOR TRAINING FOR THE PUBLIC MEMBER OF THE PALMDALE RECYCLED WATER AUTHORITY BOARD

WHEREAS, on September 26, 2012, the City of Palmdale and the Palmdale Water District both approved a Joint Powers Agreement (JPA) creating the Palmdale Recycled Water Authority (Authority); and

WHEREAS, on February 20, 2013, the Authority appointed the Public Member from a public advertisement for volunteers; and

WHEREAS, Section 4.11 of the JPA states that compensation for work performed by the Directors on behalf of the Authority shall be borned by the Member Agency that appointed the Director; and

WHEREAS, the Section 4.11 of the JPA also states the Authority may adopt by resolution a policy relating to the reimbursement of expenses incurred by Directors and that the City and District may provide for compensation and/or reimbursement of expenses to the Public Member, as allowed by law; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has set aside funds from the sale of recycled water for compensation and training expenses; and

WHEREAS, on April 6, 2016, the City adopted Resolution No. CC 2016-045 authorizing compensation and reimbursement for training for the Public Member from revenue received from recycled water sales; and

WHEREAS, on April 13, 2016, the District adopted Resolution No. 2016-06 authorizing compensation and reimbursement for training for the Public Member from revenue received from recycled water sales; and

WHEREAS, on May 18, 2016, the Authority adopted Resolution No. 2016-006 authorizing compensation for the Public Member of the Authority and reimbursement of expenses for training incurred by the Directors of the Authority; and

WHEREAS, having established the authority and budget to compensate the Public Member of the Authority, the Board of Directors now wishes to establish the compensation schedule and adopt the form through which the Public Member may seek compensation for attendance at Authority meetings.

SECTION 2. The Board of Directors of the Palmdale Recycled Water Authority hereby incorporates the compensation of the Public Member in its 2016 budget. The compensation of the Public Member shall be allocated from the Recycled Water Sales.

SECTION 3: The Board of Directors of the Palmdale Recycled Water Authority hereby adopts the Palmdale Recycled Water Authority Director Meeting Compensation Form, attached hereto as Exhibit A.

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE PALMDALE RECYCLED WATER AUTHORITY ESTABLISHING A POLICY TO ADD AGENDA ITEMS TO FUTURE AGENDAS

WHEREAS, the Authority does not have a policy by which Directors may add items to future agendas; and

WHEREAS, the development of a policy by which Directors may add items to future agendas is necessary to ensure all items of importance to the Authority are adequately discussed and addressed; and

WHEREAS, on August 17, 2016 the Authority Board discussed the development of a policy for Directors to add items to future agendas and directed Authority Counsel to prepare and bring back a resolution describing the Authority's policy for Directors to add items to future agendas.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE PALMDALE RECYCLED WATER AUTHORITY DOES HEREBY FIND, DETERMINE, RESOLVE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: An agenda item titled "Requests for New Agenda Items" shall be added to every meeting agenda.

SECTION 2: The Board of Directors of the Palmdale Recycled Water Authority hereby establishes the following policy by which Directors may add items to future agendas:

- A. When the agenda item titled "Requests for New Agenda Items" is reached in a public meeting, any Director may suggest a future agenda item and explain why it should be set on a future agenda.
- B. In order for an item to be placed on a future agenda by a Director appointed by a Member Agency, it must be proposed by a Director appointed by one Agency and seconded by a Director from the other Member Agency. For example, an item proposed by a Director appointed by the City of Palmdale may only be seconded by a Director appointed by the Palmdale Water District.
- C. In order for an item to be placed on a future agenda by the Public Member, it must be seconded by a Director appointed by either the City of Palmdale or the Palmdale Water District.
