




EARTH DAY 2025 WATER CYCLE POSTER CONTEST

Contest Requirements:

- Posters must be 8.5" x 11" in size.
- Each entry must include:
- Student's name, grade, teacher, and school
- A creative title
- A visual representation of the water cycle
- A brief message on the importance of water conservation

Judging & Awards:

Entries will be evaluated based on creativity, completeness, and neatness. First, second, and third-place winners will be selected in each grade category:

- Grades K-2
- Grades 3-4
- Grades 5-6
- Grades 7-8
